






### THE OBJECT OF THE GAME IS TO WORK TOGETHER AS A TEAM TO MAKE DIFFERENT SHAPES




STEP 1 All teammates hold the rope with two hands.


ON "GO" MAKE A STAR. READY, GO!



STEP 2 Activity leader calls out a shape and then says "GO!"




STEP 3 Teams work together to reshape the rope into the shape called out by the activity leader.



**STEP 3** Teams carefully place the shape on the floor, Step back and wait for their work to be evaluated for quality.
