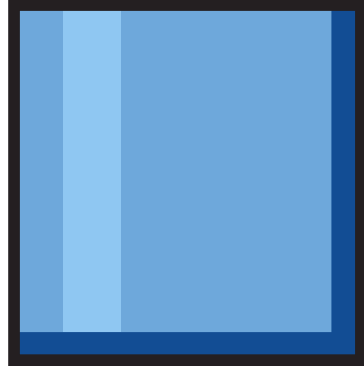
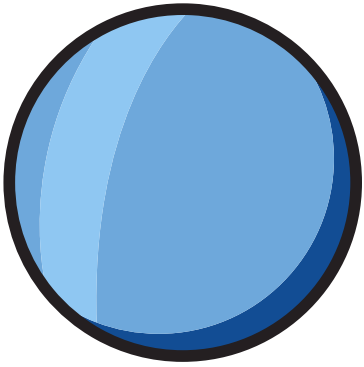

ALL TEAMMATES HOLDING IT WITH TWO HANDS.

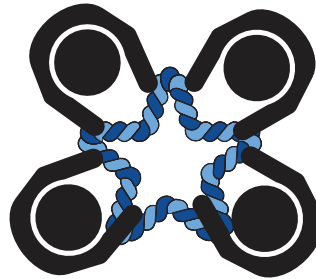


STEP 1 All teammates hold the rope with two hands.

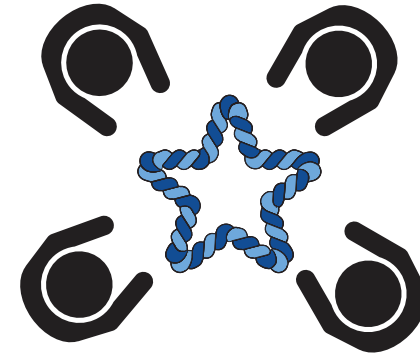
ON "GO" MAKE A

then says "GO!"



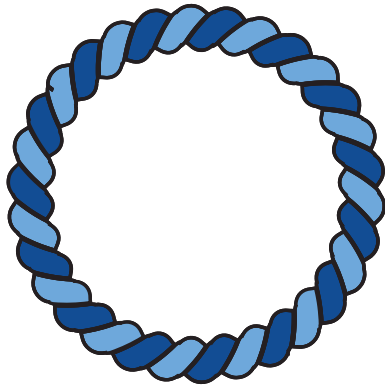
STEP 3 Teams work

out by the activity leader.



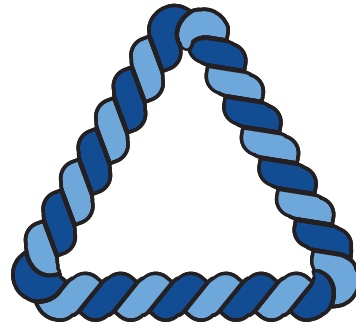
STEP 3 Teams carefully

USING ONLY EYE CONTACT WITH TEAMMATES (LEVEL 3)

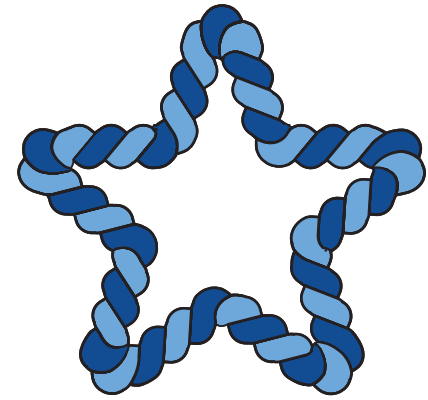

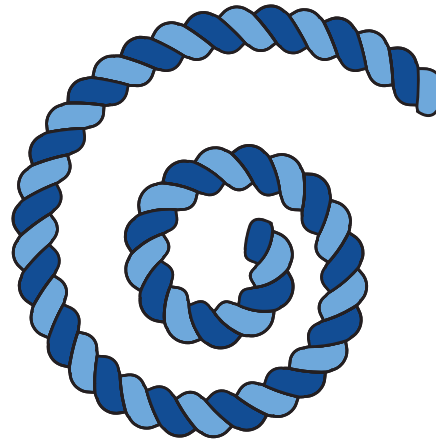
